Dear Parent/Guardian,

Following on from previous letters regarding the supervised asymptomatic testing of pupils on their return to school in September, we can now give you more information regarding these days. Pupils need to enter the school site through the pedestrian gate on Park Road. Testing will take place in the Sports Hall and pupils need to arrive so that they can make their way to the Sports Hall for the start of their allotted testing time. Please note that there will be no entry to the school site via West Road for pupils who are attending school to be tested.

Testing for years 8,9 and 10 on Friday 3rd and Tuesday 7th September will follow exactly the same

timetable. Testing on Monday 6th September for years 7 and 11 will take place whilst they are in normal school lessons and pupils will be told when to go for their test on that day.

We anticipate that pupils will have had their test and be leaving the school premises by the start time of the session that follows theirs.

If you are going to be dropping off and collecting your child please be aware that the school car parks will all be closed and it may get congested at the bottom of Park Road if there are a large proportion of families doing this. Can we also inform you that due to safeguarding no parents will be allowed on the school site with pupils.

We will be sending an e-mail out shortly to request consent. If you have a child in years 8-11 and gave consent for asymptomatic testing in school previously then you do not need to give consent again. However, if you did not give consent for your child in years 8-11 to be tested last time and you would like to now, please could you complete the consent form. Year 7 pupils will all need to be given consent via a link on the e-mail that you will be receiving.

Thank you for your support in this matter and we look forward to welcoming the pupils back in September to what we hope will be a more 'normal' year!
